

By purchasing a PC from Aviator PCs, you agree to these Terms of Service. Please read this carefully before ordering.

Orders are taken via email, social media, or other messaging platforms.

Full payment is taken before anything is ordered or done.

Orders may be cancelled before parts are purchased, but after that, payments are non-refundable.

Aviator PCs is not responsible for price changes after an order is placed.

Standard builds are finished within 1 month after all parts arrive.

Builds with the \$50 speed fee are finished within 1 week after parts arrive.

Aviator PCs' build time does not include shipping time.

Nationwide shipping is available currently.

Aviator PCs is not responsible for shipping damages once the PC has been handed to the carrier.

If a PC arrives damaged, customers should contact their carrier and file a claim.

Aviator PCs will provide necessary documentation if needed.

All PCs come with a 1 year limited warranty that covers hardware malfunctions and assembly errors.

Warranty does not cover:

- Accidental damage, misuse, or customer-caused damage.
- Overclocking damage
- Software-related conflicts, including viruses or OS corruption
- Entire hardware replacements (e. g., replacing a GPU or CPU)

Repairs:

- If your PC qualifies under the warranty, you can request a repair with a \$5 fee.
- Customers are responsible for shipping costs both ways.

Support inquiries are typically answered within a week but may be longer in certain circumstances.

Support is available for technical assistance and minor troubleshooting, but software-related support is not covered.

Aviator PCs is not responsible for any issues arising from customer modifications, including hardware changes, software installation, overclocking, or system tampering.

PCs are built and tested to function properly upon shipment.

Customers are responsible for proper setup and maintenance.

Aviator PCs reserves the right to modify these Terms of Service at any time.
